### WHAT CHILDREN LEARN



#### Social understanding

Who is who in a family, who looks after whom, and what each person does in a day.



#### Language

Family words, names, 'my' and 'your', and the first sentences of pretend talk.



#### Emotional literacy

Tired, hungry, happy, cross. Feelings given to a figure are easier to name than one's own.



#### Sequencing

Wake, breakfast, out, home, bath, bed. A day has an order, and so does a story.



#### Fine motor

Click the arms and legs into sitting, standing, waving. Lift the baby in and out of the cot.



#### Early maths

How many people, how many chairs? Bigger and smaller, older and younger.

### ONE SET, FIVE YEARS OF PLAY



### TRY THIS ON DAY ONE



#### Baby In, Baby Out

**12–24 months** · Put the baby to bed, wake the baby up. Say goodnight and good morning every time.



#### Who Is This?

**18 months – 3 years** · Name the family one by one. Then match each figure to someone in the child's own family.



#### A Day at Home

**2–4 years** · Wake up, breakfast, out to play, home, bath, bed. Act out the day in order.
